NOTICE OF THE DEFINITION/ADOPTION OF AN AD HOC DEVELOPMENT SETBACK LINE IN TERMS OF THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT ACT, 1998 (ACT NO. 107 OF 1998), AS AMENDED ("NEMA") AND THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT ("EIA") REGULATIONS, 2014 (AS AMENDED) WITH RESPECT TO THE FOR THE PROPOSED SINGLE RESIDENTIAL DWELLING ON A PORTION OF ERF 1896, FRANSKRAALSTRAND

Dear Registered Interested and Affected Party,

This notice serves to inform you that the Western Cape Government Environmental Affairs and Development Planning (DEA&DP), Directorate: Development Management, has adopted the ad hoc development setback line for the proposed single residential dwelling on a portion of Erf 1896, Franskraalstrand. The setback line is defined for the purpose of construction of a single residential dwelling.

Please note that the decision was issued and dated 27 November 2023. The Decision outlines the conditions of adoption, reasons for the decision, recommendations, and the appeal process. Any Responding Statements to an Appeal lodged, should be submitted within 20 days from the date of receipt of the appeal submission.
